The gong is known as an instrument of transformational power. It is a tool by which we are engulfed in total sound, and through our intuition, we are brought back to optimum health and balance. The Gong Bath consists of 14 Planetary Gongs (example: Earth which resonates with OM) - they range in size from 36" in diameter to 22" in diameter. Each gong is embellished with the glyph of the planet that is the orbital frequency of it's planet. The meditation begins softly with the soundings of small planetary bowls, which have a profound calming effect on the listener: the attention is directed inward. Then the heavy sound of the large planetary gongs is permeating the air.

The gong bath will end with a gentle shower of sounds, bells, bowls, a rattle and/or a round brass disc which when played upon, has a very long resounding tone.

We will set the intention that we let go and are in a space of New Growth & Gratitude.

The bath will last approx 1 1/4 hours.
